TOURNAMENT RULES

1. USBC sanctioned ~ membership cards will be shown.
2. There will be two divisions: MIXED and SENIOR MIXED (50 years or older as of October 29, 2016).
3. Teams will consist of mixed four-persons (can be 3 men & 1 woman or 3 women and 1 man). The Mixed Division may not have more than 3 seniors on a team. The Senior Mixed Division may not have any bowlers under the age of 50 as of October 29.
4. MULTIPLE PARTICIPATION ALLOWED. (USBC rule 315b & c) Not more than TWO players on one team can place more than once in the prize list for position standings. A singles participant can enter any number of times but cannot place more than once in the prize list for position standings.
5. Entrants must use their highest sanctioned league average regardless of whether bowled as a regular member or as a substitute. Averages will be accepted in the following order:
 - a) Highest previous season book average of 21 or more games; if none,
 - b) A composite average of all USBC leagues, including leagues with less than 21 games bowled.
 - c) If no 21 game average is available, men will enter with a 155 average and women with a 145 average.
6. The following USBC rules will be effective for this tournament:
 - a) 319a, 2 ~ if an entrant's current average of 21 or more games is 10 pins higher than the prior season's average, the current average must be used (verified by association manager).
 - b) 319a, 3 ~ bowlers are responsible for verifying their own averages, whether submitted by the team captain or others.
 - c) 319c and 319d ~ average adjustment & reporting prior prize winnings will not apply
7. Entries, **WITH FULL FEES**, will be scheduled as received. The schedule shall not be changed except for an emergency. The lineup shall be the same as shown on the entry form.
8. Handicap shall be 90% and based on the difference between each individual's average and a scratch figure of 225.
9. Prize money will be returned 100%, with at least one prize for each eight (8) entries, or fraction thereof, in each event and division.
10. Any player or team arriving after the squad has begun will be allowed to bowl and scores will count beginning in the frame then being bowled.
11. Captains **CHECK IN** the entire team and singles check in **ONE-HALF HOUR** prior to the scheduled bowling time. If a substitute is necessary, the tournament manager must be notified **ONE HOUR** prior to the scheduled time of bowling.
